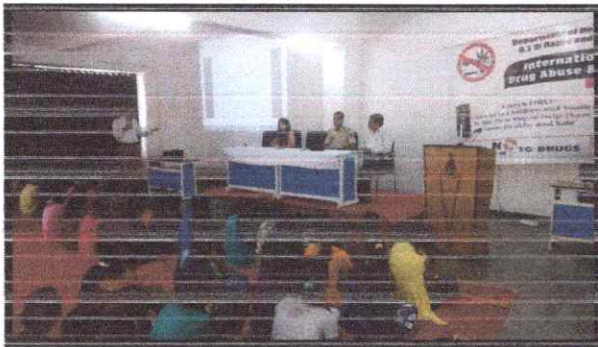


Program Report

Seminar on “Drug Abuse and Illicit Tracking in Adolescent”
