




Date: 15 July 2021 Time: 10:00 am to 12:00 noon

A first lecture, of an Expert Lecture Series from Industrial Resource Persons, was delivered online by Shri Ashwin Patel, Asst. General Manager, QC department, at IPCA Laboratories Ltd., Piparia, Silvassa. Dr. Sureshkumar L. Chavda, Asst. Professor (Chemistry) escorted the resource person to the staff room 3C, for the expert talk. The session was conducted on On-Line Platform of Google Meet, due to COVID-19 situations. The session started at 10:05 AM, wherein Mrs. Aparna Tailor, gave a brief introduction about the event and the resource person. Shri Ashwin Patel sir delivered a talk on "Overview of QC department in Pharma Industries" for the final year B. Sc. students (Semester VI). Total of 63 participants, including 58 students, took an advantage of interacting with the resource person. Sir started the session with brief introduction about the need for development of Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) and Quality Control (QC) departments.
