

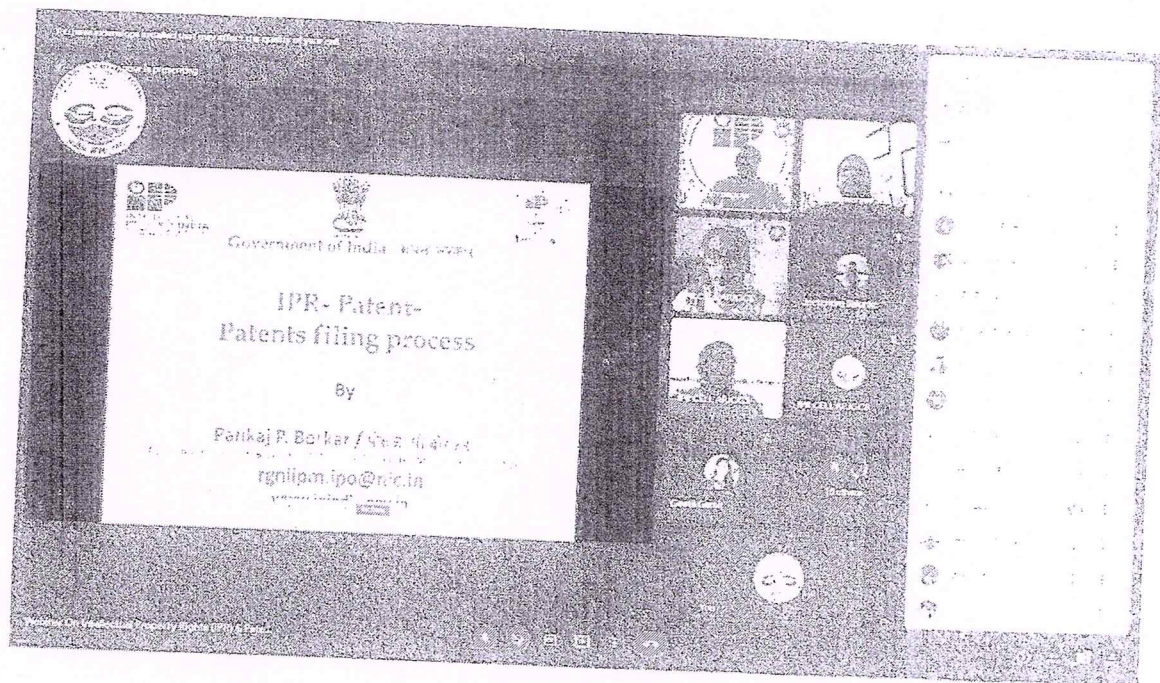
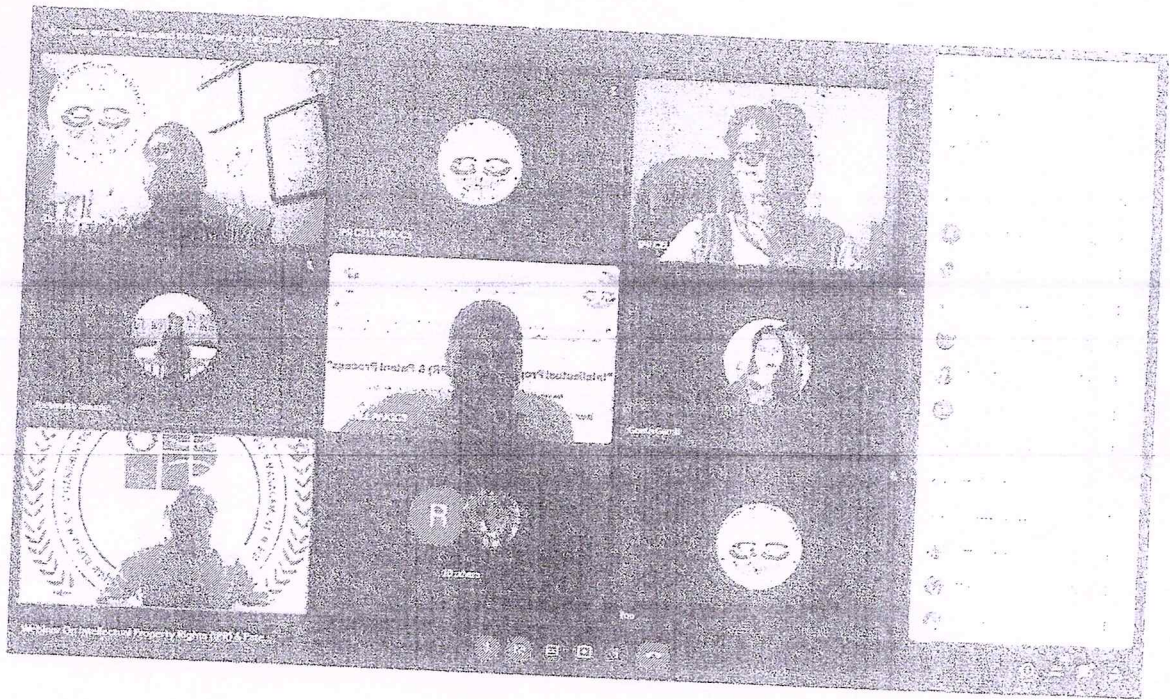

Dr. Bhagwanjee Jha, Principal of the college welcomed Shri Borkar sir and gave a brief introduction to sir about the college. Mrs. Aparna Tailor, Assistant Professor (Microbiology) has introduced the speaker to the participant. Shri Borkar sir explained the meaning of intellectual properties and their importance with example. He also described various forms of intellectual properties like Design, Trade Mark, Copyright, Geographical Indication and Patent in a very lucid manner. Sir also explained about the process of patent filing in India and the location of the various offices for the same. He encouraged and emphasized taking interest in patent filling and motivated the participants to apply for patents. Patents for the Inventor were elaborated. Sir also informed about carrier opportunities in the field of IPR management and motivated the participant..

Participants also inquired about legal actions for IPR infringement. Shri Borkar sir answered all the queries and questions raised by the participants, with clear and elaborative explanation. 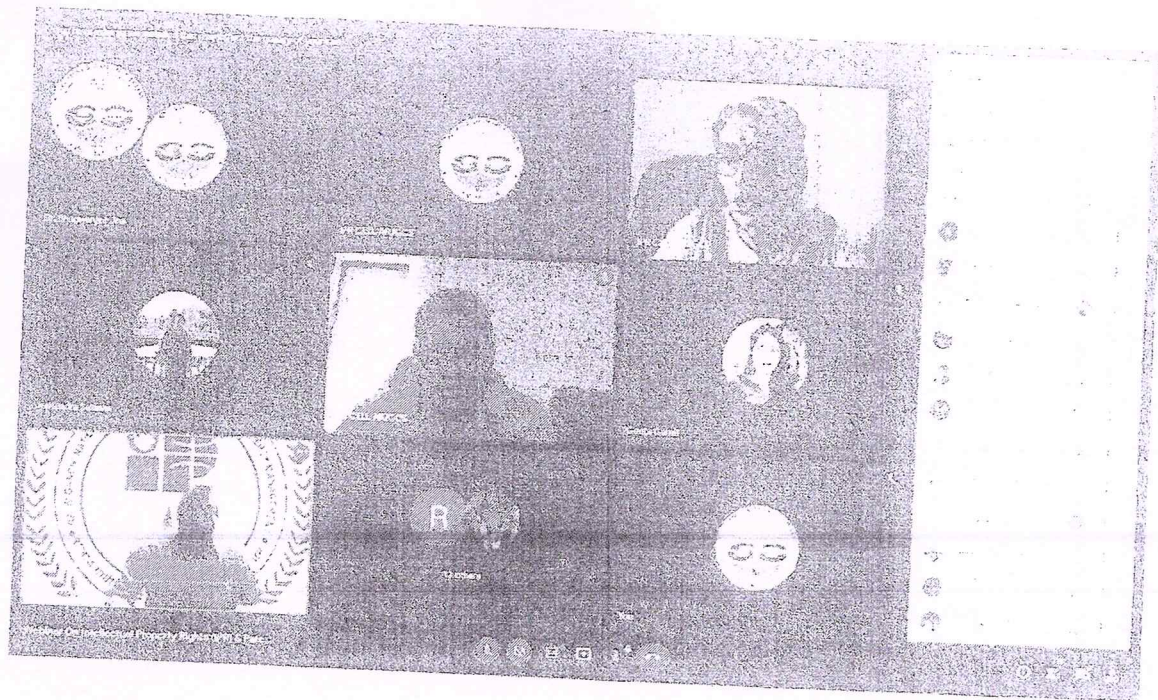
