



Report on Celebration of
161st Birth Anniversary of Acharya Prafulla Chandra Ray

2nd August 2022 was 161st birth anniversary of Acharya Prafulla Chandra Ray (regarded as the father of chemistry in India). To celebrate this event various competition such as (i) Seminar competition, (ii) poster competition (iii) Scientific Cartoon (Sci-Toons) (iv) Quiz competition (v) Skit/Drama competition was organized on the theme of "**Chemistry in Human Body**" by the Department of Chemistry, Faculty of Science, Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam Government College, Silvassa.

The celebration was inaugurated with lamp lighting and Saraswati Vandana by the students. Then there was the screening of documentary movies based on the life and achievement of Acharya Prafulla Chandra Ray to make students aware of the contributions of Acharya to the development of Chemistry in India and also industrial development in India. All staff members of the Science and some staff from Arts and Commerce faculty graced the inauguration with their presence.

Then after there was theme base seminar competition in which a total of 10 seminars were presented by students. Students present a seminar on the chemistry of Hormones, Chemistry of Hair, Chemistry of body odour, hydrocarbons, Vitamins, DNA, Proteins, etc. The Competition was judged by Dr. Prakash Patel and Mr. Jagadish Surywanshi and based on parameters like content, knowledge, structure and overall presentation 1st, 2nd and 3rd winners were decided. The seminar competition was coordinated by Dr. Sureshkumar Chavda.

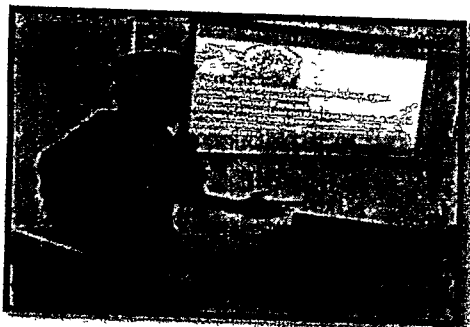
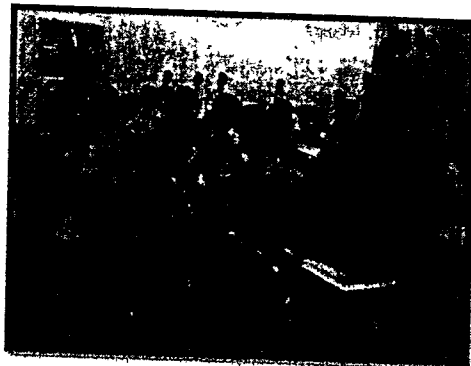
In the poster competition total of 23 students participated individually as well as in a team of two members. There were a total of 14 posters. Students have prepared posters with pictorial representations and written descriptions. There were posters on the importance of carbons in the human body, Chemistry of the human body, Chemistry behind nail polish, Electrolytes in the human body etc. In the poster competition 1st, 2nd and 3rd winners were judged by Dr. Aparna Tailor and Dr. Sureshkumar Chavda. The seminar competition was coordinated by Mr. Jagadish Surywanshi.

After the poster competition, a Quiz competition was organized. Four teams of three members were prepared for a quiz competition after the screening test. A total of 48 students participated in the screening test. The quiz competition has a total of four round which includes direct questions, visual questions, word Jumble and rapid fire. All questions are chemistry based. Dr. Sony Amredra and Dr. Rama Mittal have coordinated the events as quiz masters. Due to a tie, there were two winners of the quiz competition.

At last, there was a Skit/Drama competition in which a total of three teams participated. Students have presented their Skit/Drama based on the theme of Chemistry in the Human Body.

Through, skit students have explained the functions of hormones, the importance of medicine, the importance of good food habits, the bad consequences of drinking alcohol and explain how chemistry is involved in various functions of the human body. Dr. Mukesh Nayak and Dr. Sony Amredra have judged the Skit/Drama competition. All students and staff have thoroughly enjoyed skit/dram competitions.

In all competitions, students participated enthusiastically and celebrated the 161st birth anniversary of Acharya Prafulla Chandra Ray in a meaningful sense. all the science faculty members, laboratory staff, student volunteers, administrative staff and housekeeping staff contributed to making this event successful.

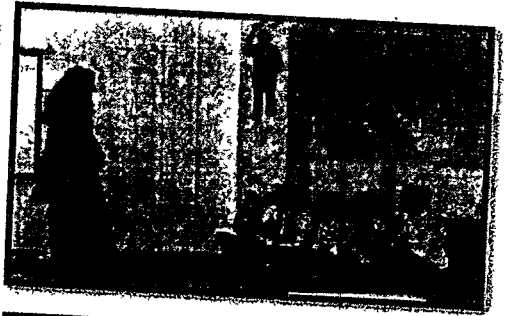
